

Resident Podiatrist Recruitment and Selection:

Recruitment: Applicants are recruited from all CPME accredited colleges of Podiatric Medicine through direct mailings to Podiatric students, Advertisements in national periodicals and Participation in hospital visitation days sponsored by colleges of podiatric medicine.

Selection Criteria: The most qualified candidates will be selected based on the following criteria:

- Academic Performance
- Clinical Skill
- Interpersonal Qualities

The Resident Podiatrist shall be worthy in character, manner and ethical conduct and possess an attitude that is conducive to learning and functioning within the hospital environment. Admission to the program is not influenced by race, color, sex, religion, creed, national origin, age or handicap.

Application Process: All applicants must submit an application through the Central Application Service for Podiatric Residencies (CASPR) according to CASPR submission guidelines.

Application Materials:

- The CASPR application including National Board Part I and II Scores
- Curriculum Vitae
- Official transcript of medical school record to demonstrate successful completion of his/her studies to date
- Three Letters of recommendation from faculty members who have supervised his or her medical training
- Current photograph

Eligibility: To be eligible for consideration applicants must:

- Be scheduled to graduate from a CPME accredited College of Podiatric Medicine prior to residency program start date of July 1.
- Pass Part I and II of the National Boards prior to residency program start date of July 1.
- Proof of US Citizenship or work visa.
